Main purpose of the job:

• To work under the direct instruction of the Senior Midday Supervisor to provide support for the pupils.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Securing the safety, welfare and good conduct of pupils during the midday break period.
- 2. Supervising the pupils in the dining hall, playground areas and school premises and may include ancillary associated duties (i.e. cleaning up spillages, ensuring tables are clean etc.) and ensuring the maintenance of good order and discipline.
- 3. To work together as a team to ensure children are supervised at all times.
- 4. To keep children suitably occupied inside the building in the event of bad weather.
- 5. To encourage the children to behave well by following the school's behaviour policy.
- 6. To play games with the children on the playground.
- 7. To carry out minor First Aid, fill in the Accident book and any other necessary paperwork.
- 8. To report all serious incidents to the School Business Manager and Head teacher.

- Exercises judgement in reporting any serious concerns about behaviour or possible safety or security risks.

- Working outside in playground.
- Toilet areas, off the playground, to be checked at regular intervals to ensure children's safety.
- Report to the class teacher and Senior Midday Supervisor any children who are consistently not eating their meals.
